Lodging Options

There are four major chain hotel options in Alliance, all located on the western end of State Street. They are all very close in proximity to both Saturday's reunion dinner and Sunday's picnic. From westernmost to easternmost, they are:

- [Comfort Inn](#), 2500 W. State Street
- [Holiday Inn Express and Suites](#), 2341 W. State Street
- [America's Best Value Inn](#), 2330 W. State Street
- [Hampton Inn and Suites](#), 1831 W. State Street

All four have breakfast included in the room cost. America's Best Value Inn, the Comfort Inn, and the Hampton Inn are pet-friendly (extra fee involved). The least expensive option normally is America's Best Value Inn, with the Comfort Inn also in the relatively lower range; the Holiday Inn Express and Hampton Inn are comparatively newer (particularly the Hampton) and pricier, and they fall generally within the same ballpark of each other pricewise. For Hilton Honors members, Hilton currently has a summer sale for multiple-night stays that provides substantial savings; be aware, however, that the cancellation deadline for reservations made at the sale price is two weeks ahead of the arrival date.

Other relatively nearby chain hotels are available in Hartville ([Comfort Suites](#), about 25 minutes away from the reunion dinner), the Canton area (numerous hotels, generally about 30 minutes away), and Salem ([Holiday Inn Express](#), about 30 minutes away). Non-chain hotels are also scattered throughout the area.

Bed and breakfast and vacation rental options in Alliance and the surrounding vicinity are available through [Airbnb](#), [Vrbo](#), and other vendors.
