Your Tickets: Janet will send you your tickets on June 8 electronically. PNC Park uses digital tickets on your smartphones for ticketing. Let me know if digital tickets are a problem for you, and we will meet up to get you into the Park.

Transportation is on your own. Mark and I can take two additional passengers comfortably or three additional passengers up-close-and-friendly. I will be parking near my office downtown and slowly walking about a mile to PNC Park.

Parking is available on the North Shore near the stadium or downtown (a 0.5-mile walk across the Roberto Clemente Bridge). Parking reservations are a good idea. Spaces can be reserved in advance through ParkMobile, SpotHero, or other smartphone apps.

[PNC Park Bag Policy | Pittsburgh Pirates \(mlb.com\)](#): Each guest is permitted to bring one bag into the ballpark (purses, fanny packs, backpacks, etc.) provided that the bag is soft-sided and 16" x 16" x 8" or smaller. Bags exceeding these dimensions will not be permitted inside the ballpark. All bags are subject to search.
